Declaration on the Non-Use of Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS)

PFAS, or raw materials intentionally containing PFAS, are not used or intentionally added in the manufacturing processes at Pyroll's Kouvola site. The packaging complies with the applicable PFAS-related requirements set out in Article 5 of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on packaging and packaging waste (PPWR).

This statement is based on supplier Declarations of Compliance and relevant statements, together with Pyroll's internal process control.

Testing of a newly introduced printing ink series is currently in progress. The results are expected during August 2026 and will be incorporated into the compliance assessment once available.

Representative Total Fluorine (TF) screening is currently being conducted by an external ISO/IEC 17025-accredited laboratory on packaging samples processed through Pyroll's production process. The testing serves as supplementary verification to support the assessment that the converting and printing processes do not introduce PFAS-related fluorine residues above the applicable regulatory criterion.

Based on the information available to Pyroll at the date of issue, the packaging materials supplied by Pyroll conform with Regulation (EU) 2025/40 to the extent applicable on the date they are placed on the market. The recipient is responsible for verifying the suitability of the packaging for the intended packed product and conditions of use.

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
